Biography

Torsten Moritz holds a Ph.D. in political sciences from the Free University of Berlin and has extensive research experience in Eastern and Central European transformation since 1989. Having been involved in the leadership of various pan-European Youth networks in the late 1990s, he has since 2002 worked for the Churches' Commission for Migrants in Europe (CCME) as executive secretary on EU policy and projects.

In this capacity, he carries out CCME's advocacy work with the European Parliament and the European Commission, as well as the Council of Europe and the interregional global ecumenical network on migration of the World Council of Churches. He is active in conceptualising and implementing a variety of projects and initiatives, among other issues on migration and (co) development, trafficking in human beings, refugee resettlement and integration of third-country nationals.
