- 2014 **OUR WORLD WAR**. Directing 2 films for BBC about troops in World War One. Scripts by Joe Barton. Series producers Sue Horth and Colin Barr.
- 2013 **SIEGE IN THE SAHARA**. Drama/doc for Nutopia and Channel 4. 2013 **NIGHTSHIFT**. Directing Jimmy Gardner's script for World Productions as single film for Sky Arts Playhouse strand.
