Biography

Cosimo Zene is former Head of Department and currently Reader in the Study of Religions, at the School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS), University of London. He has published on ex-Untouchables (*The Rishi of Bangladesh*, 2002), on Gramsci (*The Political Philosophies of A. Gramsci and B. R. Ambedkar*, ed. 2013), on anthropology in Sardinia (*Dialoghi Nulesi*, 2009), on intercultural and inter-religious dialogue, and various articles on gift-giving. Having recently finalised an ethnographic film on this latter topic (*S'Impinnu – The Vow*, 2014), he is currently preparing an extended monograph (*Itineraries of the Gift*). He is also working towards the introduction of a new BA World Philosophies programme at SOAS and coordinating an international Editorial Board for a World Philosophies Series (Mimesis International).
